Episode 1 – Psychosocial Disabilities and Cultural Barriers [22mins 58secs]

This episode features Sophie Duterte from the Centre for Culture, Ethnicity and Health and Mohamed Umar, a Support Coordinator from Neami National and an NDIS participant. They discuss:

- What is psychosocial disability?
- CALD Community Perspectives and Experiences
- Disparities of Understanding and Building Relationships.

Episode 2 – Personal Stories, Misunderstandings and Contexts [24mins 10secs]

In this episode, Sophie and Mohamed continue the conversation, starting with Mohamed discussing his experiences as a Support Coordinator and sharing insights into his personal experience with applying for the NDIS. Discussions also include:

- Distinctions Between Terminology and Concepts
- The importance of goals and aspirations
- Mohamed's personal story and experience.

Episode 3 – Improving the NDIS and the Role of Interpreters [12mins 32secs]

This episode draws on how the NDIS can be improved and Sophie discusses the role of interpreters during an individual NDIS journey. Discussions include:

- Ways the NDIS can better cater CALD community needs
- Advice for interpreters for NDIS journeys
- Should interpreters have bigger roles?

Episode 4 – The Future of the NDIS [13mins 38secs]

This is the final episode with Mohamed and Sophie, in which they discuss their goals and aspirations for the future of the NDIS. Discussions also include:

- The difference between support coordinators and support workers
- Resources and where to find help
- What Sophie and Mohamed would like to see in the future from the NDIS.
